INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL BRIEF:

NEW US ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & TRAVEL RESOURCES

The National Restaurant Association Show urges all members of our international show community to start making travel plans now to avoid any potential delays in obtaining the documentation required for entry to the United States. To help your planning process, please review some of the important planning considerations below.

SCHEDULE US VISA APPOINTMENTS NOW

If you or your staff require a US visa to travel to the United States, the National Restaurant Association Show encourages you to start your visa application process as soon as possible. U.S. embassies and consulates are working to resume routine visa services on a location-by-location, but visa applicants may face extended wait times for visa appointments.

Check your local <u>U.S. Embassy and Consulate's website</u> for information regarding operating status and which visa services it is currently offering. If you're a citizen of one of the <u>41 countries participating in the Visa</u> <u>Waiver Program</u>, you may travel to the United States for tourism or business for 90 days or less without obtaining a visa.
